

HOLY LAND 2023 SCHEDULE OF PAYMENTS

Deposit of \$700 due November 3, 2022

Second payment of \$1,635 due January 12, 2023

Final payment of \$1,635 due March 23, 2023

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing.

Up to 120 days before departure you will be charged \$250 in cancellation fees

119 days to 60 days before departure you will be charged \$500 in cancellation fees

59 days to 30 days before departure you will be charged \$750 in cancellation fees

30 days before departure to date of departure you will be charged \$1000 in cancellation fees

Note: In addition to cancellation fees, if cancellation occurs after Holy Cross Tours has made payment to a supplier such as an airline or hotel, that cost will not be refunded.

The cost of the pilgrimage: The price quoted is in US dollars and is based on airfare, tariffs and exchange rates as of September 2022. That could change at any time. The cost of the pilgrimage is estimated until the airline tickets are issued. In the case the group size is less than 20 passengers, the right is reserved to raise the cost accordingly. If the pilgrimage is cancelled due to lack of participants, full refunds will be given. If the pilgrimage is cancelled due to government warnings, war, terrorism or any other reasons outside the control of Holy Cross Tours refunds will not be given.

Registration and deposit: A deposit is due at the time of booking. By giving the deposit and submitting the booking form you are agreeing to the terms and conditions put forth by Holy Cross Tours.

Airplane tickets: The price of your package is based on a round trip economy class ticket. All fuel taxes and surcharges are included in the trip price and are subject to change until airline tickets are issued.

Hotel accommodations: Accommodations are based on double occupancy. Single rooms must be requested on the booking form. There is no guarantee as hotels have a limited number of single rooms. Upon receipt, your request will be submitted to the hotels.

Travel documents: You must have a passport that is valid for at least six months after the date of your return flight. US citizens will receive a free entry visa upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. Non US citizens should contact their embassy to inquire about visa requirements and fees to Israel. Holy Cross Tours is not responsible for acquiring passports or visas to Israel.

Travel Insurance: Travel insurance is optional, but highly recommended.

Responsibility clause: Holy Cross Tours is a tour operator that will build your trip as a whole by making all the arrangements and reservations needed. Holy Cross Tours does not perform or assume liability for the performance of any of the individual suppliers. All suppliers providing travel, hotel accommodations and other services are independent contractors, not agents or employees of Holy Cross Tours.
